Hilfe für den Pazifik nach Cyclone PAM

Vor einigen Wochen haben wir über den **bfe** Verteiler um Unterstützung für das von Cyclone PAM verwüstete Vanuatu gebeten. Insgesamt kamen EUR 5421,40 zusammen, die wir in mehreren Tranchen sowohl in die Hauptstadt Port Vila als auch nach Tanna transferiert haben. Bearbeitungsgebühren haben wir selbstverständlich nicht erhoben.

In Port Vila unterstützen wir Betu Watas, der im Jahr 2009 für das Ausstellungsprojekt ["UrSprung in der Südsee"](#) in Deutschland zu Gast war und dessen Haus durch PAM vollkommen zerstört wurde.

Besonders schwer getroffen von PAM wurde die Insel Tanna im Süden des Vanuatu Archipels. Hier helfen wir Jacob Kapere, den Direktor des Tanna Cultural Center, beim Neuaufbau der Infrastruktur.

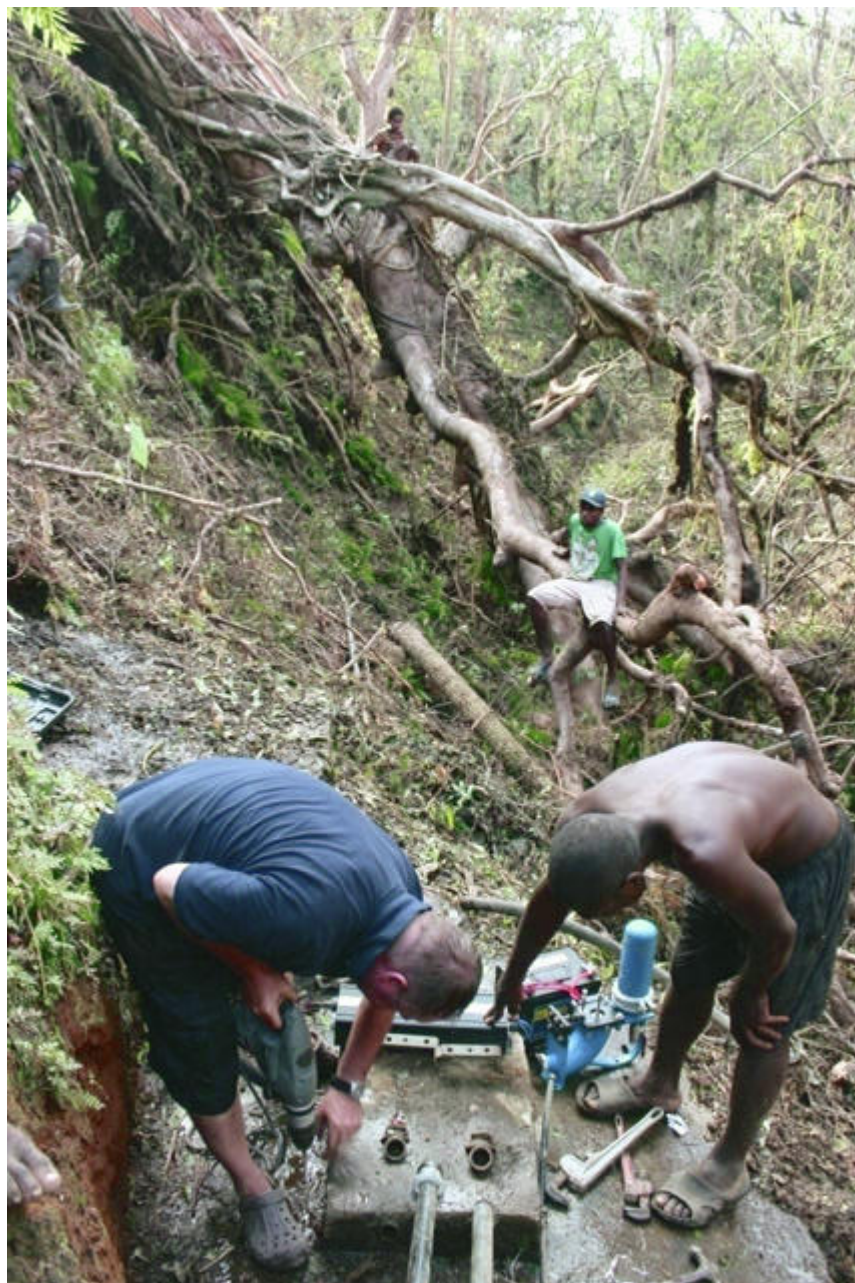
